#### **POLICY**

Dilico welcomes persons with disabilities who are accompanied by a support person on the parts of our Agency that are open to the public and other third parties.

### **PROCEDURES**

- 1. A person with a disability will not be prevented from having access to a support person. In certain cases, Dilico might require a person with a disability to be accompanied by a support person for health and safety reasons.
  - a. Before making a decision, Dilico must consult with the person with a disability to understand their needs; consider health and safety reasons based on available evidence; and determine if there is no other way to protect the health and safety of the person or others on its premises.
- Confidential information may be discussed in the presence of a support person and as a result, Dilico will require signed consents regarding disclosure of information. If a different support person is used for subsequent meetings, a new signed consent will be required.
- 3. Fees will not be charged for the support person. Authorization for expenditure for any costs associated with a support person required by Dilico must be secured in advance.
