CHILD WELFARE SERVICES

- Emergency services will continue to be available 24 hours a day.

HEALTH SERVICES

- Anemki Family Health Team Clinic, will be providing services through virtual visits. Walk-in will also be provided through scheduled virtual visits.

- Primary Care services will focus on providing essential services until further notice.
- Additional essential health services continue to operate and care for the health needs of clients.

MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES

- All 24 hour residential programs continue, however intake is suspended until further notice
