If you are interested in a placement with Dilico you are required to send your resume, cover letter and [Dilico application](#) to studentplacements@dilico.com. Please indicate which service area you would like to complete your placement in e.g. mental health or health services.

Once your application is received by the service manager you will be contacted. We do require that all students have a Criminal Records Check along with a Vulnerable Sector screening that is dated within the last 6 months.
