Our Services

The RAAM Clinic provides low barrier access for individuals seeking treatment for any substance use disorder.

With a coordinated and interprofessional approach, the clinic provides a full range of care at the time of need.

We provide evidence informed addiction care which includes:

- Opioid Replacement Therapy
- Alcohol Urge Reduction Medication
- Nicotine Replacement & Urge Reduction Medication
- Motivational Interviewing
- Cognitive Behavioural Therapy
- Addiction Counselling

Transportation is provided if needed.

Our team offers a safe and non-judgmental space, where individuals receive specialized services and care in a healing environment.

The RAAM Clinic offers a full team of professionals:

- Medical Doctor
- Nurse Practitioner
- Registered Nurse
- Counsellor / Social Worker
- Traditional Healer
- Peer Support Worker

Process for individuals visiting the RAAM Clinic:

1. Engagement
2. Assessment
3. Individualized care could include:
 - Counselling / Psychotherapy
 - Peer support
 - System navigation
 - Comprehensive care programs
 - Suboxone treatment/Methadone support
 - Withdrawal management
 - Residential treatment
4. Short-term care
5. Monitoring treatment progress
6. Referral to longer-term support, if required
